NON-BINDING PUBLIC ADVISORY QUESTION

Calling upon Holtec Pilgrim, LLC, owner of the closed Pilgrim Nuclear Power Station and Holtec Decommissioning International, LLC, to immediately withdraw any plans to discharge any radioactive water into Cape Cod Bay. WHEREAS, Cape Cod Bay is a federal and state protected area and habitat for the endangered Right Whale; and WHEREAS, Cape Cod Bay provides a vital livelihood for fishermen and the tourist industry; and WHEREAS, The National Academies of Science has determined there is no safe dose of ionizing radiation, WHEREAS, One radioactive element in Holtec Pilgrim water is Tritium, which concentrates up the food hand from sediment to sea grasses to the fish we eat; and WHEREAS, Holtec Pilgrim can discharge radioactive water anytime without approval of the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC); and WHEREAS, The Attorney General of New Mexico has filed a lawsuit against the NRC for unlawful proceedings and illegal activities involving Holtec; and WHEREAS, The Commonwealth has the authority to stop the dumping; Therefore, shall the people of the Town of Brewster direct the local government to communicate with Governor Charlie Baker, Attorney General Maura Healey, and the State Legislature to employ all means available to ensure that Holtec commits to immediately withdraw any plans to dump any radioactive water into Cape Cod Bay?
